Details of Daily Working*:

Insert day-by-day figures and indicate in the vertical column marked "Remarks*" all relevant details as to reasons for stoppages such as breakdown of pumps, strikes, shortage of cargo, etc. Moreover, in this box should be stated reasons and duration of delays before berthing, during berthing, between moored and commenced loading, during loading, between completed loading and leaving berth and after leaving berth. Same applies to discharging.

General Remarks*:

This box should be used for insertion of such general observations which are not covered in any of the boxes provided for in the first main group of boxes, for instance, delays on account of slow pumping, excess back pressure, or other general observations.
